







Ethnicity Estimates

- They are only estimates
 - They are generalizing thousands of years of migration
- They have changed recently
 - More DNA samples are available
 - More detailed research has been performed
 - They will probably change again (and again and again...)



DNA Matches

- To have genealogical value, your DNA results must be compared to other DNA samples
- DNA testing identifies others who match your DNA
 - Close (genetic) relatives will share a lot of DNA
 - Distant (genetic) relatives will share less DNA
 - Unit of measurement: Centimorgans (cM)

Laura Larsdatter was born in Eidsvold Verk, Akershus, Norway on 14 October 1844. The Eidsvoll church records were destroyed by a fire in the Eidsvold church rectory in 1877, so records documenting her birth do not appear to exist. After extensive research I now believe that her parents were Lars Abrahamsen Rødshaugen and Anne Margrete Larsdatter.






Benefits of Using Family Search Family Tree

- They reportedly are working on similar capabilities for Germany




