She was a mail-order bride but decided that she could not marry whoever the gent was, so worked and paid off the debt and later met and married Anton. I remember her saying she had worked for a Dr's family with many children, and they taught her English. Plus the American way of life. Do you remember Gram's nephew coming to visit us on Chestnut St in Hinsdale? he had a wife and I think 2 small children, the little girl had cancer in her eye, and she later died, He was a minister in Orange, New Jersey, I am not sure which religion, but would think maybe Lutheran, I think you were in the area of 8 years old then.

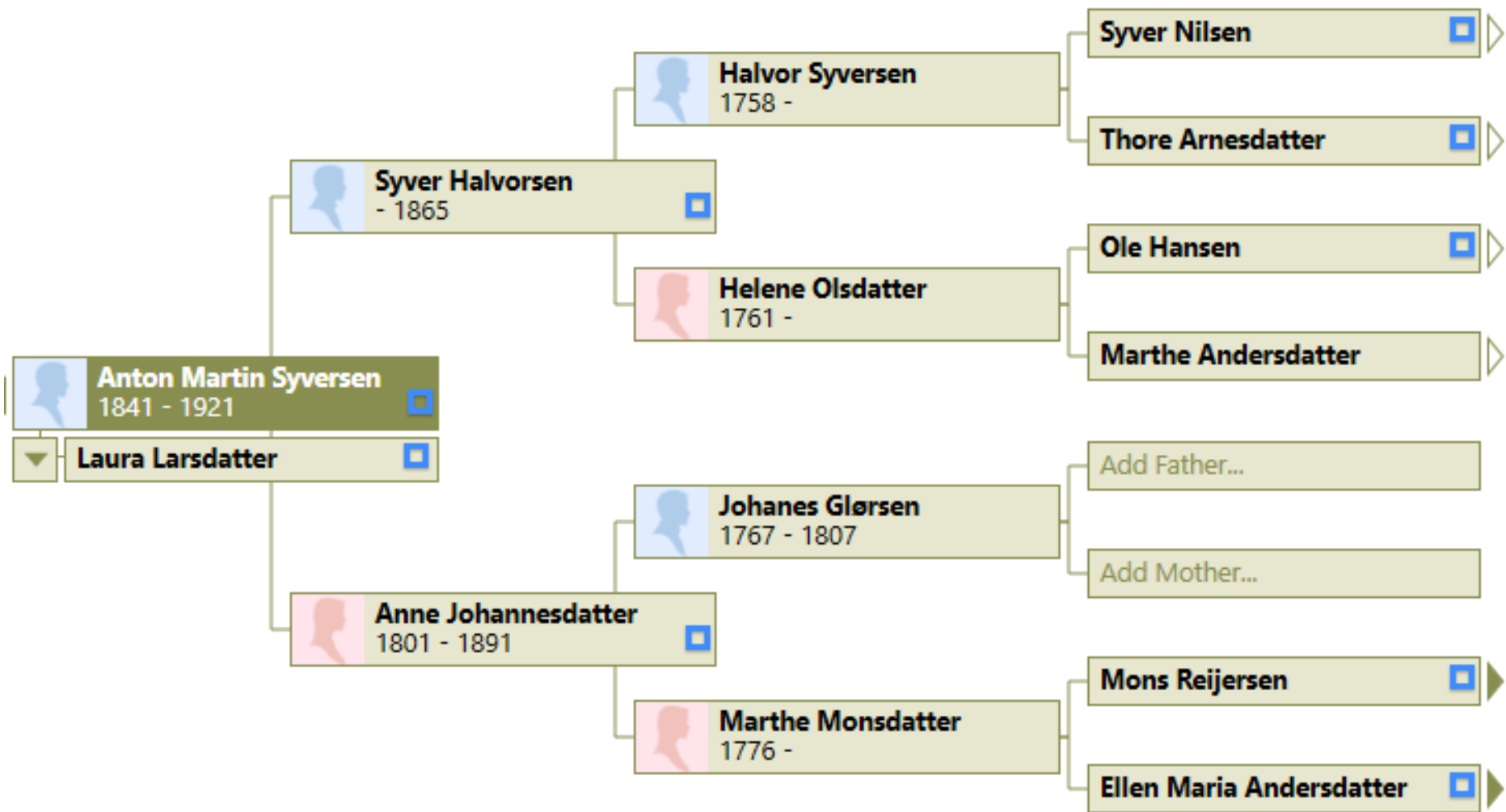

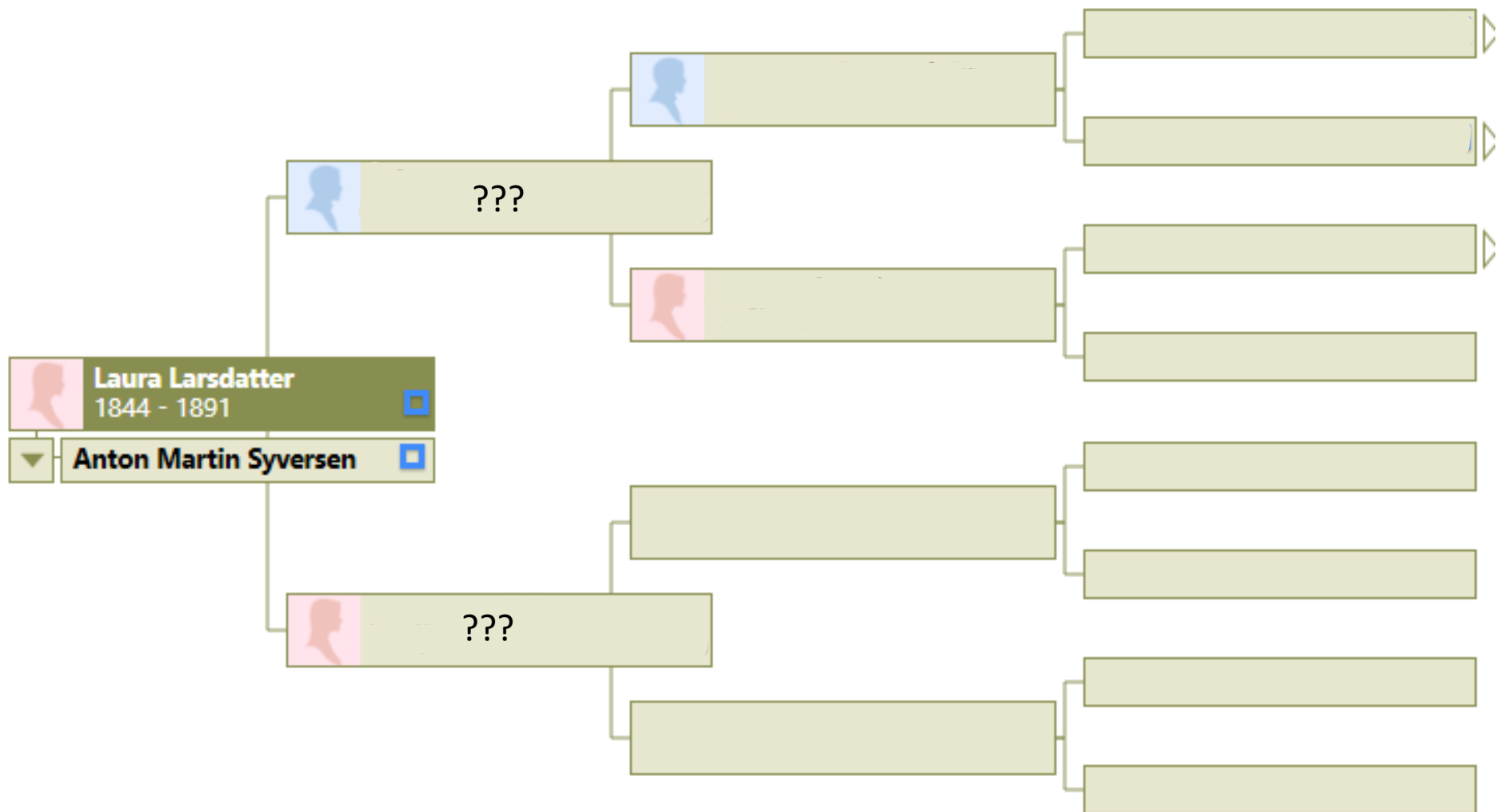

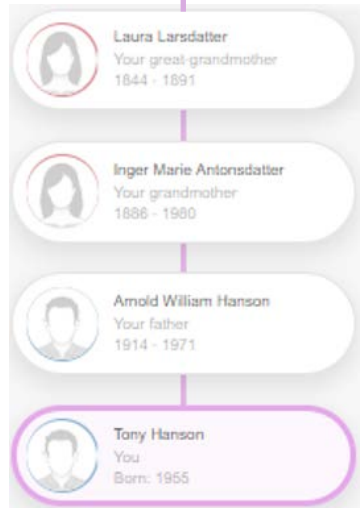






Laura Larsdatter

- Born 14 October 1844 in **Eidsvold**, Akershus, Norway.
- The Lutheran Church was the official information repository for all Births, Marriages and Deaths.
 - Two copies were kept.
 - Both copies were destroyed in a fire in 1877.

Lars Halvorsen's Living in Eidsvoll:

- **Lars Halvorsen** (b. 1783) and his wife Maria Christophersdatter (b. 1788) were living with their son Christian Larsen (b. 1825) and his wife Marthe Andersdatter (b. 1825) and their daughter Marte Christiansdatter (b. 1862) at the time of the 1865 census ([view the transcription](#)). He would have been 61 when Laura was born and 94 when she was married.
- **Lars Halvorsen** (b. 1825) living on the Lesjabraaten Tudlidalen in Eldsvold Prgj. at the time of the 1865 census ([view the transcription](#)). He was married to Maren H Armundsdatter and had three daughters (Albertine, b. 1858, Alava b. 1862 and Berte b. 1865) and a son (Hakon, b. 1860). Laura's birth date (1844) is not a good fit for this family, although it is possible.
- **Lars Halvorsen** (b. 1830) living on the Johnsbraatebakken in Eldsvold Prgj. at the time of the 1865 census ([view the transcription](#)). He was an unmarried border and would have been 14 years old at the time of Laura's birth, so he probably is not her father.

Start with conventional genealogical research

- Build your tree using standard genealogical practices and resources
 - Take advantage of the hints they provide.
- Investigate & document collateral lines (siblings, spouses, etc...) too.
 - This will be helpful later when you start trying to associate DNA matches.

Utilize All Known Sources of Information

- Identify sources of information
- Begin a methodical search looking for clues
- This is where a **Research Log** is really useful!
 - **Who** were you looking for?
 - **What** did you search?
 - **Where** were the records you searched?
 - **When** did you perform the search?
 - **Why** were you searching this particular record?
 - Document the results (i.e., did you find what you were looking for?)

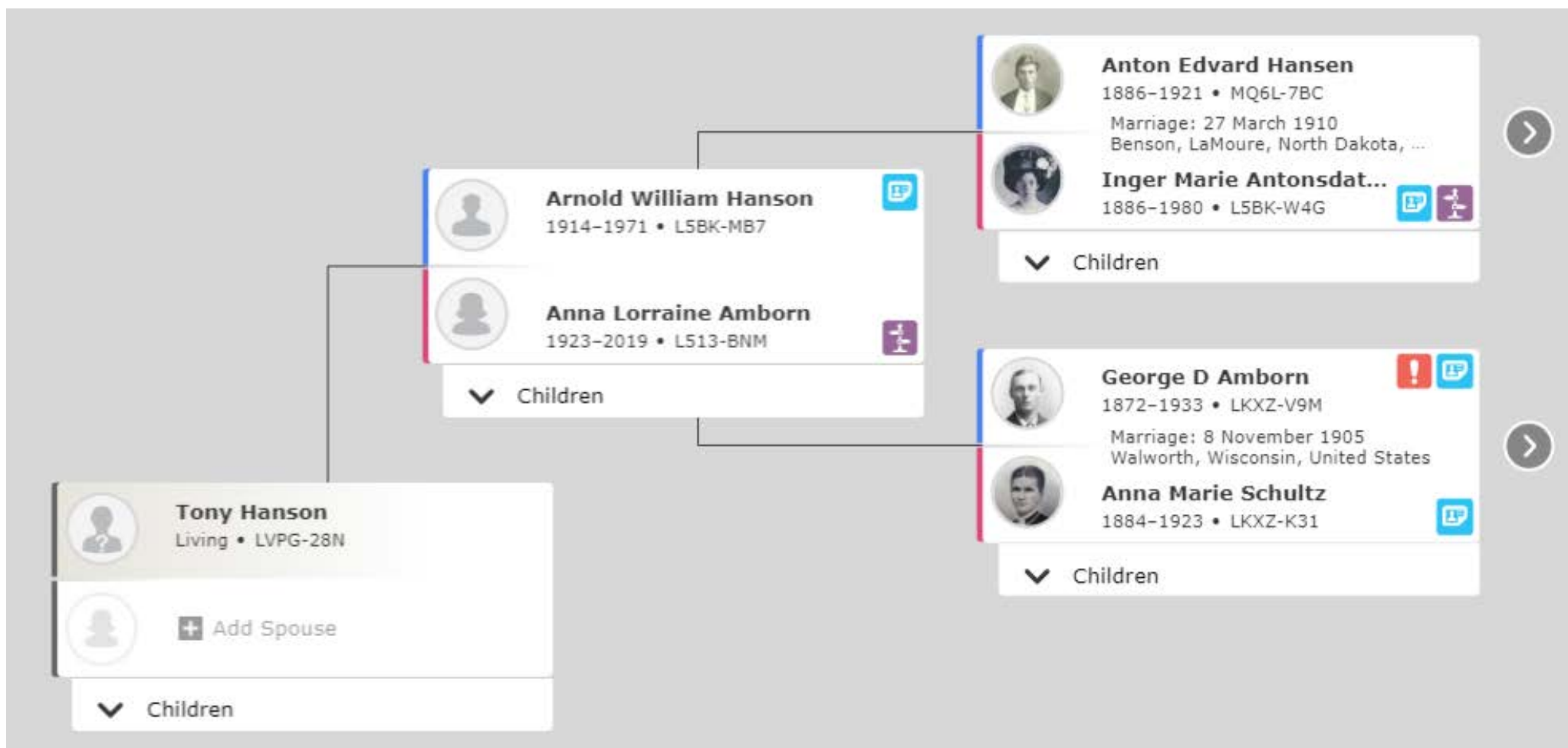

Why Utilize the Family Search Family Tree?

- Somebody may have already documented part of the family branch that you are researching.
- Family Search will notify you about changes to anybody you “Watch”:
 - If anybody makes a change (addition, modification, deletion)
 - If they index a document that appears to be related
- Makes it very easy to collaborate with other researchers.

European Ancestors?

- Try MyHeritage
- They tend to have more European-centric records than Ancestry.com

Who To Test With?



- Start with **Ancestry.com**
 - They have the largest collection of DNA samples
 - They do a good job of integrating DNA and your tree
 - ThruLines tool is very useful
 - You can download your DNA information and upload it to other companies at no/low cost
 - Although you may not have access to all offered features

Who To Test With?



- Strong European focus
- Upload Ancestry DNA information to start at no cost
 - Consider taking full test to have access to all features
- Allows you to download DNA information for matches
 - You can take advantage of DNA Painter & GEDMatch
- Theory of Family Relativity is also a powerful tool
 - It is only updated periodically (a few times each year?)



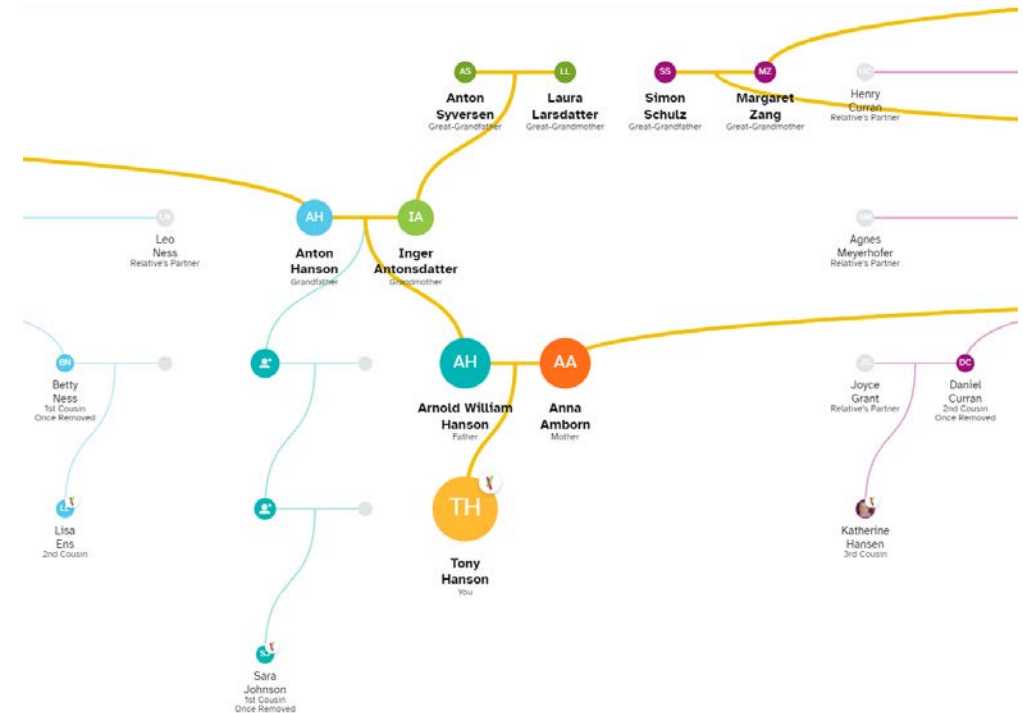
Who To Test With?

- You can upload your Ancestry.com DNA results
- This is (almost) the only choice if you want to do Y-DNA or Mitochondrial testing
- You can upload/maintain a tree, but it is not well integrated with your DNA information
 - You can link a DNA test to a person in the tree...

Who To Test With?



- Not focused on the genealogical segment of the market
- Will NOT allow you to upload DNA information from Ancestry.com
- Tree is useful
 - But it is limited to 200 entries

Who To Test With?

- One Sample – All Tests included
- You can upload you Ancestry.com DNA sample at no cost
 - You will NOT get mtDNA or Y DNA results though...
- Extremely focused results for United Kingdom
 - Claim to be developing the same for German

Identify DNA matches of interest

- ThruLines & Theory of Family Relativity
- Surnames
- Geography

Start with the living person and work backwards

When you identify a match of interest:

- Add them to your tree
- Add siblings, parents and other relatives
- Take advantage of hints
- Try to connect them to a relative you have already documented using other sources

- Use tools provided by each testing company
- Use tools provided in your family tree software

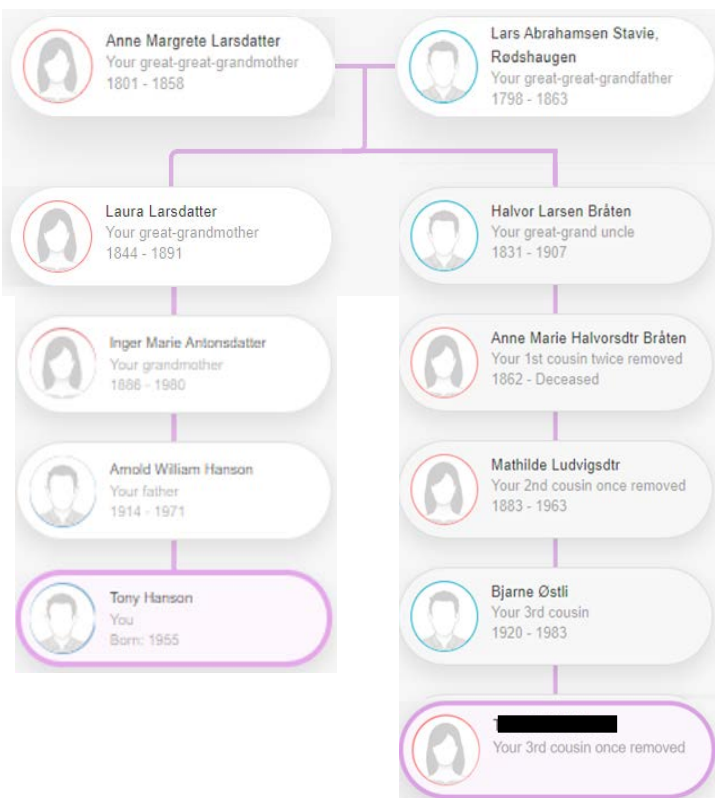

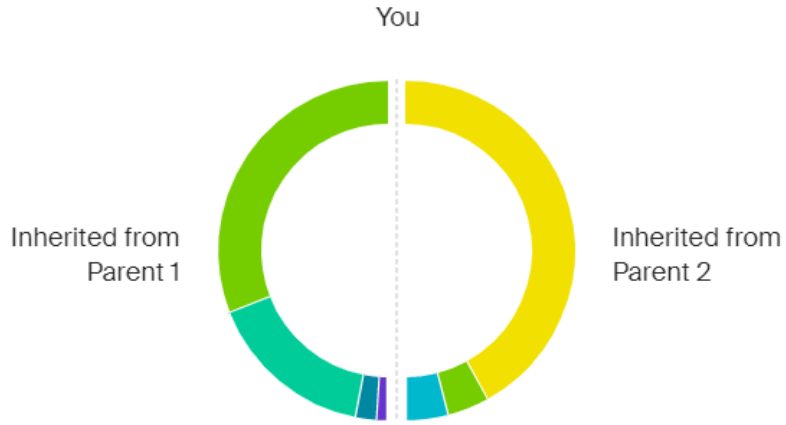

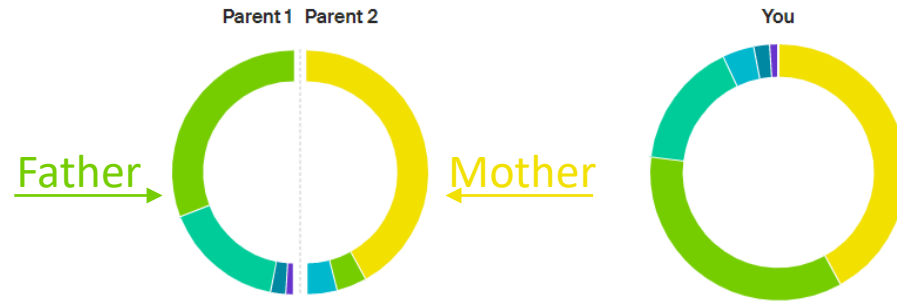

I have not been able to identify her family using conventional genealogical records because all of the Eidsvoll church records were destroyed by a fire in the Eidsvold church rectory in 1877 (see "[Eidsvoll Parish, Akershus, Norway Genealogy](#)" at FamilySearch for more information about Eidsvoll records).

This page outlines all that I know about her life and what I believe about her family.

Date & Place of Birth and her Father's Name

The following facts were recorded when she married Anton Martin Syverson in Eidsvoll on 24 March 1877. The same date and location were also recorded in her 1891 death record.

- Her date of birth (14 October 1844).
- Her place of birth (Eidv. Verk)
- Her father's name (Lars Halvorsen) [*As will be shown, this may not be correct*].
